























Spiritual Father of Blessed Mariam Thresia (1902-1926)

- •Fr.Joseph Vithaythil 37 years old and Mother Mariam Thresis 26 year old.
- •For Mariam Thresia tests, temptations, diabolic attacks, sickness, mystical experiences of God, stigmata etc.
- •Fr.Vithaythil was the only refuge for the sisters and for her family members.
- •He spent hours in prayers and acts of deliverance in Mother Mariam Thresia's room which caused misunderstandings, criticisms etc.
- Fr.Joseph Vithaythil was of clear conscience and moral courage. He was committed to do the will of God at any cost.
- •1913 Ekanthabhavan for prayer was built and given to Mother Mariam Thresia and her friends.
- •Mar John Menacherry asked Fr. Joseph Vithaythil to keep a diary documented all the events in the daily life of Mother Mariam Thresia. He wrote and kept everything secret and handed over the same to Mar George Alappatt in the year 1957.
- •Mar John Menacherry presented a book as a complement which was helpful to guide the souls.
